Gift Aid

Adrian Bell (for Kirkby Lonsdale) and Joe Armistead (for Hornby and Caton) are our administrators and hold records of all Gift Aid donors. Please contact them if you require further information, want to commence a new Gift Aid (standing order) donation, or cancel an existing declaration. They should also be notified of any changes of name or address or in the event of a Gift Aid donor no longer paying sufficient income or capital gains tax.
