"Bishop Brian was found collapsed at his home at Laburnum Cottage yesterday [Sunday 20.10.19] and was admitted to Arrowe Park Hospital, Birkenhead. He received the Sacraments on admission to hospital and remained serene and cheerful though he was given no prospect of recovery. I was able to pray and speak with him last night. He received excellent support and care in hospital and lost consciousness earlier today before passing quietly from this world at 1.20 pm.
