## Gift Aid

As a charity, our Parishes are able to claim an extra 25p for every £1 donated by parishioners, through HMRC's Gift Aid tax incentive. Current rules permit us to reclaim this tax providing donors formally declare that they want to donate through Gift Aid. In addition, Gift Aid donors must be UK taxpayers and must pay an amount of income tax at least equal to the tax reclaimed on

all of their Gift Aid donations to all charities in any one tax year. Adrian Bell (for Kirkby Lonsdale) and Joe Armistead (for Hornby and Caton) are our administrators and hold records of all Gift Aid donors. Please contact them if you require further information, want to commence a new Gift Aid (standing order) donation, or cancel an existing declaration. They should also be notified of any changes of name or address or in the event of a Gift Aid donor no longer paying sufficient income or capital gains tax.

## Easter Triduum Planning Meeting
